1. A candidate is expected to complete a minimum of 12 experiments covering all the four core subjects (Advanced General Psychology, Life Span Psychology, Advanced Social Psychology and Organizational Behaviour) to fulfill the academic requirement as per the curriculum.
2. The candidates are required to spend One Full Day (Morning Two sessions and Afternoon Two sessions) to enable them to complete all the 12 experiments representing the four core subjects.
3. Around 10 **candidates** will be grouped in one batch to complete all the assigned experiments
4. It is decided to conduct the Practical Sessions in Fourteen batches on one day concurrently by Fourteen Faculty Members so that (10 Candidates x 10 Batches and 9 candidatesX4batches) 136 **candidates** will be covered on One Single Day.
5. Note: Students are directed to bring the Experimental Psychology Course Material Issued by SDE Bharathiar University along with writing materials and Calculator. **(Student's without Experimental Psychology Course Material will not be allowed to attend the Classes)**
