(t) "University Grants Commission" means the Commission established under section 4 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (Central Act 3 of 1956);

(u) "University Laboratory" means a laboratory maintained by the University, whether instituted by it or not, and intended for the carrying on and advancement of research work ;

(v) "University Lecturer", "University Reader" or "University Professor" mean Lecturer, Reader or Professor respectively, appointed or deemed to be appointed as such by the University;

(w) " University library" means a library maintained by the University, whether instituted by it or not.

CHAPTER II

THE UNIVERSITY

3. The University — (1) There shall be a University by the name "The Bharathiar University".

(2) The University shall be a body corporate, shall have perpetual succession and a common seal and shall sue and be sued by the said name.

(3) The headquarters of the University shall be located within the limits of the city of Coimbatore or in any place within a radius of twenty-five kilometres around those limits.

4. Objects and powers of the University : — The University shall have the following objects and powers, namely : —

- (1) to provide for instruction and training in such branches of learning as it may determine;
- (2) to provide for research and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge;
- (3) to institute degrees, titles, diplomas and other academic distinctions ;
- (4) to hold examinations and to confer degrees, titles, diplomas and other academic distinctions on persons who --

(a) shall have pursued an approved course of study in a University college or laboratory or in an affiliated or approved college, unless exempted therefrom in the manner prescribed by the statutes and shall have passed the prescribed examinations of the University; or

(iii) Sections 13 and 14 in Part II and section 27 in Part III shall be deemed to have come into force on the 7th January 1982.

(b) shall have carried on research under conditions prescribed ;

(5) to confer degrees, titles, diplomas and other academic distinctions on persons who shall have pursued an approved course of study in an autonomous college;

(6) to hold examinations and to confer degrees, titles, diplomas and other academic distinctions on persons who shall have pursued an approved course of study by correspondence whether residing within the University area or not, and to provide such lectures and instructions for persons not being residents within the University area under conditions prescribed;

(7) to confer honorary degrees or other academic distinctions under conditions prescribed;

(8) to institute, maintain and manage institutes of research, university colleges and laboratories, libraries, museums and other institutions necessary to carry out the objects of the university;

(9) to affiliate colleges to the University as affiliated, professional or postgraduate colleges under conditions prescribed and to withdraw affiliation from colleges;

(10) to approve colleges providing courses of study for admission to the examinations for titles and diplomas of the University under conditions prescribed and to withdraw such approval;

(11) to designate any college as an autonomous college with the concurrence of the Government in the manner and under conditions prescribed and to cancel such designation;

(12) to institute lecturerships, readerships, professorships, and any other teaching posts required by the University and to appoint persons to such lecturerships, readerships, professorships and other teaching posts ;

(13) to institute and award fellowships, travelling fellowships, scholarships, studentships, bursaries, exhibitions, medals and prizes in accordance with the statutes;

(14) to establish, maintain and manage hostels, to recognise hostels not maintained by the University and to withdraw recognition therefrom;

(15) to exercise such control over the students of the University through the colleges as will secure their health and well-being and discipline;

(16) to hold and manage endowments and other properties and funds of the University;

(17) to borrow money with the approval of the Government on the security of the property of the University for the purposes of the University ;

(18) to fix fees and to demand and receive such fees as may be prescribed ;

(19) to make grants from the funds of the University for the maintenance of a National Cadet Corps ;

(20) to institute and maintain a University Extension Board ;

(21) to institute and provide funds for the maintenance of

- (a) a publication bureau ;
- (b) an employment bureau ;
- (c) students' unions ;
- (d) University athletic clubs ; and
- (c) other similar associations;

(22) to encourage co-operation among the colleges, laboratories and institutes in the University area and co-operate with other Universities and other authorities in such manner and for such purposes as the University may determine;

(23) to recommend to the Government the recognition of any area within the University area as a University Centre; and

(24) generally to do all such other acts and things as may be necessary or desirable to further the objects of the University.

5. Colleges not to be affiliated to any other University and recognition of institutions by the University :--- (1) No college within the University area shall be affiliated to any University other than the Bharathiar University :

(2) No institution affiliated to, or associated with, or maintained by any other University in the State of Tamil Nadu shall be recognized by the University for any purpose except with the prior approval of the Government and the concerned University.

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ONLINE PROGRAMME (OL) FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Do the classes meet at a specific time during the week?

A: Yes, all the online courses offered by SDE, BU on par with UGC-DEB regulations. The live sessions are scheduled on weak end (Saturday and Sunday) as per the UGC-DEB Norms for Delivery of Courses in Online Mode.

Q: What is the time commitment for the OL Programmes?

A: Candidates are asked to go through the UGC OL Programmes Regulations, 2020 using this link <u>https://deb.ugc.ac.in/Home/Regulations?Year=2020</u>. As per the norms of UGC-DEB, candidates should spend 30 total hours of study per credit.

Q: Can I receive course materials for these OL Programmes?

A: Soft copy of E-learning materials with video content is provided to all the enrolled students of OL Programmes. For your information, a four-credit course shall typically have 20 hours of video content and 20 hours of reading material as per the norms of UGC-DEB.

Q: How much totals hours I have to spend for under graduate online programme?

A: Total you have to spend 118 credit hours (per credit 30 hours) for UG online programmes.

Q: How do I know when a live session class will be offered?

A: For each programme, there is an individual programme coordinator to moderate all the activities of entire OL programme. In addition, each course has separate course coordinator to assist all the activities of course delivery, time schedule of live sessions, discussion for course e-learning materials, etc.,

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EXAMINATION CONDUCTED THROUGH ONLINE MODE

1. Technology Centric / Manual Proctoring

Proctoring is done through google meet or zoom meet by the invigilator, who verifies the number of students downloaded the question paper and attended the examination in each session. The invigilator also ensures uploading of answer scripts in the portal.

Manual proctoring is done inside the class rooms within the colleges by deploying adequate number of invigilators.

For every 15 - 20 students, one invigilator is deployed to oversee the examination process in each session.

2. Security arrangements for conducting examinations in online mode:

An exclusive online examination portal has been developed. In the portal, entire data base of students are mapped with the schedule of examinations and subjects codes.

The question papers which are uploaded in the portal can be downloaded on the day / session of examination before 15 minutes of the start of the examination.

Answer scripts in PDF can be uploaded in the portal within 40 minutes after the end of examination in each session.

Login credentials with username and password are provided to each student. Using the credentials, students can download the question paper and upload answer scripts in PDF.

3. Security arrangements for conducting examinations in offline mode:

Question papers and answer booklets are kept in the strong room. Used answer booklets are packed and sealed.

4. Ensuring transparency

Communication of schedule of examinations, display of nominal list of students and issue of admit cards are properly done. Results are published in the University website and copies of the results can be downloaded.

5. Credibility of examination

Conduct of examinations in a very fair manner, evaluation of answer scripts by the eligible course teachers and declaration of results on time, maintain confidentiality, etc.
